We will return the certificates and any other papers you may send as quickly as possible. Please note that if you wish for certificates to be returned by special delivery, please include a stamped addressed special delivery envelope.

- Child allowance may be payable if there are dependant children. Please see Form AW9 (pre 1/4/2008) or AW9 (post 1/4/2008) – available from the HSC Pension Service website – www.hscpensions.hscni.net
- A Death Gratuity may be payable if deceased was on pension for less than five years.
