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3	You may be affected by the public service pension remedy

Based on the information you have provided you may be able to apply for the public service remedy.

You will be able to calculate and submit your claim to HMRC on 1 October 2023 when the service is available but you can prepare now.

What you should do next

To prepare you should:

- obtain any Self Assessment tax returns you have filed from 2012 to 2022
- gather your tax records for the period 2015 to 2022 for any years you did not file a Self Assessment tax return between
- get your pension savings statements for your public service pensions between 2015 to 2022. You can obtain these from your pension scheme provider if needed.
- find details of contributions you paid to any other pension schemes between 1 April 2015 and 31 March 2022.

You may be able to access your self-assessment records through your online tax account. You can log in to your account on GOV.UK (opens in new tab).
